Trail Highlights

The trail leads the rider through remote areas of the Ozark National Forest and features spectacular mountainous terrain, scenic views, lush upland hardwood forests, unique rock out-crops, and clear mountain streams. The main trail and inside loop are connected to accommodate riders who want to vary the length of their trips.

Surrounding Areas

White Rock Mountain Recreation Area

Facilities include: cabins, lodge, camping and picnicking. For more information call 501-369-4128.

Shores Lake Recreation Area Facilities include: an 82-acre lake, swimming, fishing, hiking, camping and picnicking.

Mulberry Wild and Scenic River is one of Arkansas' premier white water streams. Facilities include grocery store, camping, and canoe rental available nearby.

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Length: 27 miles of main trail marked in blue. 15 miles of interior loops and shortcut trails.

Directions: From Fayetteville take Highway 16 east to Combs, turn south on Forest Service Road 1007 for 4 miles, and turn left on Forest Service Road 1509 ½ mile to the trailhead. From Ozark, take Highway 23 north to Cass, take Forest Service Road 1520 west 8 miles to Forest Service Road 1509, and then north 4 miles to trailhead.

Trail Information: Trail is gravel or unsurfaced; rough and rocky terrain; mile markers posted on main trail.

Site Amenities: Graveled trail parking area has a vault toilet, loading ramp and information board.

Safety: After heavy rains, beware of rising water at stream crossings. Watch for other Off Highway Vehicles (OHV), horses, and mountain bikes.

Difficulty Level: Varies - easy to most difficult.

Requirements: No camping at trailhead. State laws regarding equipment, spark arresters, and mufflers are enforced. OHV's are not allowed in recreation areas.

Recommended Items: Please do not trespass on private property bordering the trails. Bring drinking water. Remember: pick-up and pack-out all of your litter.
