Important Notice: Reviewers should provide the Forest Service with their comments during the review period. This will enable the Forest Service to analyze and respond to comments at one time and to use the information to prepare the Final Environmental Impact Statement, thus avoiding undue delay in the decision making process. Reviewers have an obligation to structure their participation in the National Environmental Policy Act process so that it is meaningful and will alert the agency to reviewers' positions and contentions (*Vermont Yankee Nuclear Power Corp. v. NRDC*, 435 U.S. 519.533, 1978). Environmental objections that could have been raised at the draft stage may be waived if not raised until after the completion of the Final Environmental Impact Statement, *City of Angoon v. Hodel* (9th circuit, 1986) and *Wisconsin Heritages, Inc. v. Harris*, 490 F. Supp. 1334, 1338 (E.D. Wis. 1980). Comments should be specific and should address the adequacy of the statement or merits of the alternatives discussed. (40CFR 1503.3)

Comments: Comments will be received by the public and other agencies for a period of 45 days following the publication of the Federal Register Notice of Availability of the Draft Environmental Impact Statement.
