Look for the types of projects that interest you. If you'd like to be involved, contact the project leader for further info.



Information on CERCLA and projects conducted under CERCLA

Most projects on Forest Service and BLM land are covered by the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA), and the agencies and the public are used to operating in this framework. However, actions relating to cleanup of hazardous waste, such as tanker truck spills and abandoned mines, are covered under a different set of laws: the **Comprehensive Environmental Response, Compensation and Liability Act (CERCLA)**. CERCLA requires public involvement and analysis of alternatives, and in that way is very similar to NEPA. The community involvement steps in the types of CERCLA actions we generally undertake (which are called “non-time-critical removal actions”) include:

1. Scoping and community interviews
2. Administrative Record file available to community
3. 30-day public review of **Engineering Evaluation/Cost Assessment (EE/CA)**, shows different alternatives, similar to an Environmental Assessment under NEPA regulations). Selected Alternative is documented in a **Removal Action Memo (RAM)**.

Projects to which CERCLA applies are **not** also analyzed under the NEPA process. For questions about the CERCLA process, call Stephanie Odell (385-1353) or Kay Zillich (385-1239).

In an effort to use existing public-notification channels, we will occasionally include CERCLA projects in this newsletter.

Glossary of terms used in this document

(CE) Categorical Exclusion: A category of Forest Service actions that do not individually or cumulatively have a significant effect on the human environment and for which, therefore, neither an environmental assessment nor an environmental impact assessment is required, i.e., road easements or parking lots.

(CER) Categorical Exclusion Review: Actions on the list of categorical exclusions that are found through review not to meet any of the 10 exceptions to categorical exclusion need not be addressed in an EA or EIS. However, a document is produced (entitled CER) that documents all these exclusions and the review process used, and is signed by a responsible official. (Utilized by BLM only)

(CERCLA) See page 3 for definition.

(COC) Colorado Case Number: A case number assigned to a particular BLM project.

(DNA) Determination of NEPA Adequacy: Actions that are covered to some extent in an existing EA or EIS may not have to be analyzed in a new environmental document. A special report (entitled DNA) is generated, stating that the existing documentation is found to be applicable to the action at hand, and is signed by a responsible official (utilized by BLM only).

(EA) Environmental Assessment (a)...a public document that serves to: 1) provide sufficient evidence and analysis for determining whether to prepare an environmental impact statement (EIS) or a finding of no significant impact (FONSI); 2) aid an agency's compliance with NEPA when no EIS statement is necessary; 3) facilitate preparation of an EIS when one is necessary. (b)...includes a discussion of the need for the proposal, the alternatives considered, the environmental impacts of the proposed action and alternatives, and a listing of agencies and persons consulted.

(EIS) Environmental Impact Statement: A detailed document undertaken for a major Federal action that significantly affects the quality of the human environment. In an EIS, the affected environment is described, a proposed action and alternatives to the proposed action are presented, and effects of the alternatives are analyzed. An EIS is prepared first in draft form. The draft document (DEIS) is sent out to interested individuals, organizations, and government agencies for review. The final document (FEIS) is prepared after analyzing and responding to the DEIS comments.

Legal Location: Township, Range, and section(s): Example "T24N,R9W, sec 9" means Township 24 North, Range 9 West, section 9.

MBF – Thousand board feet; **MMBF** – Million board feet

PID – Public Interest Determination

R.O.W. – Right-of-Way

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Scoping: The procedure by which a federal agency identifies important issues and determines the extent of analysis necessary for an informed decision on a proposed action. Scoping is an integral part of environmental analysis.
