Your reply to Ranger Sanchez' responsive statement was due on or before May 27, 2004.

APPEAL REVIEW PROCESS

Pursuant to 36 CFR 251.98(d) the appeal record closed on May 28, 2004.

This letter constitutes my review and decision on the appeal you filed regarding the 2004 Annual Operating Instructions for the Mesa Del Medio Allotment.

My review was conducted according to the provisions of the appeal regulations in 36 CFR 251 Subpart C. I have considered the appeal record, federal statues, policies, and operational procedures set out in the directives system of the USDA Forest Service.

APPEAL POINT

My review will focus on the appeal point in your March 21, 2004 notice of appeal.

Issue 1: Appellants dispute the need for a reduction in authorized on the Mesa Del Medio allotment.

Contention: The delay is based on specific reductions in authorized cattle numbers. Combined, the appellants have fewer cattle than authorized. They would prefer to enter the allotment on the normal entry dates with the total number of cattle they have available.

Response: Ranger Sanchez will be meeting in the field with the appellants and New Mexico Game and Fish Department personnel to check range readiness and discuss authorized cattle numbers. The Annual Operating Instructions issued for the Mesa Del Medio allotment allow the District Ranger to adjust the grazing authorizations in response to changes in conditions on the ground.

I find the District Ranger has complied with Forest Service operational procedures.



DECISION

After review of the appeal record, I find that the District Ranger's decision was based on a reasonable assessment of current resource objectives and conditions. The District Ranger's decision is in conformance with applicable laws, regulations, policies, and procedures. I find no evidence indicating the District Ranger has acted in an arbitrary or capricious manner. The District Ranger's decision is affirmed.

My decision is subject to further administrative review under 36 CFR 251. Any appeal of this decision to the second level must be fully consistent with 36 CFR 251.90, content of notice of appeal. Pursuant to 36 CFR 251.87(c) (2), "the appeal for a second level of review is filed with the regional forester within 15 days of the first level appeal decision. Upon receiving such a request, the regional forester shall promptly request the first level file from the forest supervisor. The review shall be conducted on the existing record and no additional information will be added to the file."
