

ELEVATION

1950 feet

FACILITIES

Vault and portable toilets
No drinking water available

BARRIER-FREE ACCIBILITY

Vault toilets are equipped with grab bars that may require some assistance.

LOCATION AND ACCESS

This site is 24 miles east of Carefree. Take Cave Creek Road 7 miles to the junction with Forest Road (FR) 205. Turn right and travel 6 miles to the junction of FR 205 and FR 19. At this junction take FR 19 for 7 miles to FR 459 and turn left. Continue on FR 459 (a paved, low speed road) for 1½ miles and an additional 1½-miles on an unpaved road to the site.

ATTRACTIONS

- Bartlett Reservoir and the Arizona Upland phase of the Sonoran Desert.
- This site offers beautiful vistas of the surrounding mountains
- Bartlett Flat has primitive boat launch opportunities for small boats
- River Access Point (RAP) for Verde River.
- Fish City at Bartlett Flat is a fish habitat improvement project. Volunteers are needed to construct and install habitat structures.

FEES

\$4.00 per vehicle
\$2.00 per watercraft per day

- Trash service
- Not recommended for trailers
