SEASON OF USE

All year

ELEVATION

2200 feet

FACILITIES

347 camp units (single, tent-only, and double) with shade ramadas, fire rings with grills, picnic tables, and water hydrants. Toilets and showers are located throughout the camp loops. There are also playgrounds and an amphitheater. Picnicking allowed only at the Blevins Picnic Site.

BARRIER- FREE ACCESSIBILITY

This site contains numerous barrier-free camp units. Toilets, showers, picnic tables, and amphitheater are fully accessible.

LOCATION AND ACCESS

This site is 6 mi. southeast of historic Roosevelt Dam.

From Mesa: take State Route (SR) 87/Beeline Highway north for about 60 miles to its junction with SR 188. Turn right onto SR 188 for 33 miles to the junction of SR 88. Continue south on SR 188 for 4 miles to Forest Road (FR) 82 (Windy Hill Recreation Site entrance). Turn left and continue for 2 miles to the site. The entire route is paved.

From the Globe area: take SR 188 north for 25 miles to FR 82 (Windy Hill Recreation Site entrance), turn right and continue for 2 miles to the site. The entire route is paved.

ATTRACTIONS

- Several miles of hiking trails in this site
- Interpretive programs are presented at the amphitheater. For additional information, contact the Tonto Basin Ranger District.
- An early pioneer cemetery is located adjacent to the Blevins Picnic Site.

FEES AND CAPACITIES

Day use and camping fees apply

Single or tent site maximum: (\$10.00 per night) 10 people, 2 vehicles, and 1 watercraft.

Double site maximum: (\$15.00 per night) 20 people, 4 vehicles, and 2 watercrafts. Picnicking fee is per vehicle.

CONSIDERATIONS

- Sewage dump facilities (no fee) are located 10 miles north on SR 188 at milepost 249 across from Cholla Recreation Site.
- Rules and regulations are posted at all fee station areas. Please read and observe.
- Please use trash receptacles, when available, or **PACK IT IN / PACK IT OUT !!**
- The adjacent boating site has two paved, high-water and two low-water boat ramps with courtesy docks and a fish cleaning station.
- Camp Hosts are usually available during the fall and winter months.

Roosevelt or Spring Creek: Compressed air, food, gas, lodging, marine services, boat rentals, public pay phone, and propane

Globe or Payson: All services
