

### SEASON OF USE

All year

### FACILITIES

#### **Peregrine Point Fishing Dock:**

- No drinking water available, restroom facilities at Dock.
- See also Butcher Jones Recreation Opportunity Guide (ROG)

### BARRIER-FREE ACCESSIBILITY

- Peregrine Point Fishing Dock angle may exceed 7% at times due to water-level fluctuations.
- The trail from Butcher Jones to Peregrine Point is paved with hand railing. Slopes average 8% and short pitches at 11%.
- Vault toilets (at Butcher Jones Day-Use Area) are fully accessible.

### LOCATION AND ACCESS

Butcher Jones Recreation Site is located 31 miles east of Mesa, on Saguaro Lake. From Mesa, travel 27 miles northeast on State Hwy. 87 to Bush Highway/Forest Road (FR) 204, and turn right (southwest). Follow FR 204 for 2 miles to FR 166 and turn left. Follow it 2 miles to Butcher Jones Recreation Site. The trail to Peregrine Pt. is east of Butcher Jones Beach.

### FISH SPECIES PRESENT

Largemouth Bass, Channel Catfish, Carp, Bluegill, Green Sunfish.

### ATTRACTIONS

- Crappie Condos, Catfish Houses, and Tire Towers are the names of some of the habitats installed along the shoreline of Butcher Jones Cove and Peregrine Cove.
- A fish census showed that 12+ lb. Bass and 30 lb. Carp are in the lake.

### CONSIDERATIONS

- Glass containers are prohibited around Saguaro Lake
- Butcher Jones and Peregrine Cove are "No Wake" areas
- No watercraft in marked buoyed area at Butcher Jones Beach
- When fishing around artificial structures, be prepared to lose a few lures and hooks
- No camping at Butcher Jones
