

TRAILS  
MAZATZAL WILDERNESS

There is a network of some 240 miles of “system” trails serving the Mazatzal Wilderness Area and contiguous areas. Their condition varies from satisfactory to very poor.

Use a great deal of caution when traveling on backcountry trails such as this one and be aware of the risks you assume.

A few brief comments are in order about the following trail:

**Y Bar Trail 44:** 4.6 miles in length. One of the more popular hiking trails. Northern end near **Barnhardt Trailhead** may be difficult to follow. Elevation: 4,200 - 7,100 feet. Termini: **Barnhardt TH** (Forest Road 419), and Trail 23.

Use of any mechanized or motorized is prohibited on this trail. No more than 15 people are allowed to be in a group. No more than 15 head of livestock are allowed in a group.
