Trail Description

Here's your chance to see the nation's record *ponderosa pine*. Adjacent to the trail, this magnificent wonder provides an excellent photo opportunity. The trail descends steadily through a forest of oaks. In the summer and early fall, one section boasts a colorful carpet of *sweet peas* and *sweet williams*. The trail leads to the Middle Fork of the Feather River. Take a walk across the suspension bridge to reach the Dan Bebee camping area. The trail continues up the south side of the canyon, reaching the top of the Hartman Bar Ridge.

(The trail is generally open from mid-June to mid-October, snow and road conditions permitting.)

Be Aware

Remote area (Bring a first aid kit)
 River is fast and cold in early and late season
 Not recommended for novice equestrians
 Steep trail - allow extra time to hike out



Note:

Open water sources are easily contaminated by human or animal waste. Water from springs, lakes, ponds, and streams should be properly treated before drinking. One recommended method of treatment is to bring clear water to a rolling boil for five minutes.
