Trail Description

The beautiful Lakeshore Trail provides a long but easy loop around the Little Grass Valley Reservoir. With access points near every campground, you can experience the trail a little at a time or all at once. In areas of the south shore and around the Peninsula Campground, the trail becomes a walk along the beach. If you look to the sky, you may see one of the *bald eagles* that nest near the south shore. The path jumps up to the main road by Horse Camp. Take the bridge across the South Fork of the Feather River, then continue down the north shore. Equestrians can enjoy the section from Horse Camp to Black Rock Creek. From Horse Camp, the Bald Mountain/Pacific Crest Trail tie provides another great recreational opportunity.

(The trail is generally open from early-June to early-September, snow and road conditions permitting.)


Be Aware:

Open water sources are easily contaminated by human or animal waste. Water from springs, lakes, ponds, and streams should be properly treated before drinking. One recommended method of treatment is to bring clear water to a rolling boil for five minutes.
