Why is the Shasta-Trinity Enhancement Fund needed?

National Forest Lands are special places, used and enjoyed by millions of people each year. As our population continues to grow, so does the demand for forest lands. Unfortunately, at the same time that the forests are experiencing an increase in demand, most Forest recreation budgets are on the decline. This means there is less money and fewer people to provide services, maintain facilities, provide interpretive programs and coordinate resource protection efforts.

What is the Shasta-Trinity Enhancement Fund Program?

In response to the discrepancies between the allocated budget and the funding needed to operate and maintain services and programs at acceptable levels, Congress passed the Recreation Fee Demonstration Program legislation in 1996. This landmark legislation, (PL 104-134), provides Federal land management agencies, like the Forest Service, with the opportunity to retain recreation user fees for local reinvestment INSTEAD of returning them to the U.S. Treasury.

Exactly how will my investment be put to work on the Shasta-Trinity National Forest?

Your money will be used to provide the things that you've said are important to you, such as increased participation in search and rescue operations, cleaner restrooms, increased garbage collection, regular maintenance of campground and boat launching facilities, more interpretive programs, and increased resource protection. Other Enhancement Fund Passes on the Shasta-Trinity National Forest include...

Shasta-Trinity Annual Pass..... \$25.00 per year

The Annual Pass is a combination pass. It is valid for the Mt. Shasta Summit Program (one individual), and the McCloud Reservoir Boat Ramp (one vehicle). One Annual Pass is valid at both of these Enhancement Fund Program Areas. For visitors who anticipate frequent visits, or who plan on staying for several days, this Pass provides an affordable and convenient alternative to purchasing multiple passes. **ANNUAL PASSES ARE NOT VALID AT CAMPGROUNDS.**

Standard Mt. Shasta Summit Pass..... \$15.00 per person

Required for recreating above 10,000 feet on Mt. Shasta. Good for one climb (up to 3 days from the date of purchase). A Shasta-Trinity Annual Pass can be substituted for this Standard Pass. People under 16 years of age are not required to purchase a Summit Pass.

Daily McCloud Reservoir Boat Ramp Pass..... \$5.00 per vehicle per day

Required at the McCloud Reservoir Boat Ramp. A Shasta-Trinity Annual Pass can be substituted for this Daily Pass.

Golden Age Passports..... \$10.00 one time fee

Golden Age Passports entitle people 62 years of age or older to a 50% discount on all recreation use fees and passes.
