New Free-use Firewood Cutting Area Opened

Klamath Falls, Oregon – A new free-use firewood cutting area has been made available to the public from the Chiloquin Ranger District of the Fremont-Winema National Forests. The Skunk free-use firewood area is located on the east side of Forest Service Road 44, west of Chiloquin.

Although the firewood is free-use, a permit is still required and there is a ten cord limit per household. Permits can be obtained at any of the Fremont-Winema National Forests offices. A map of the area will be given out when the permit is issued.

The firewood cutting areas are landings only. No standing trees or down trees outside of the landings are to be cut. The landings are numbered.

There is a lot of wood and it is easy to access. The wood has some chare on the bark but it is very sound.
