Directions:

Boggy Head Rifle Range: Just north of Moncks Corner on US Highway 17-A, turn right onto SC Highway 402. Drive 15 miles to SC Highway 41. Turn left and continue 9 miles to the rifle range entrance on the right.

Twin Ponds Rifle Range: From Charleston, take U.S. Highway 17 North for about 25 miles to Steed Creek Road (SC Route 133-S). Turn left and drive 2 miles to Willow Hall Road (F.S. Road 204). Turn right and go 1 mile to the rifle range entrance on the left.

Facilities:

- * 100-yard backstop
- * Shooting tables

Fees: None

Season/Hours: Year-round, daylight hours only

Restrictions:

- Obey all posted rifle range rules.
- Skeet and trap shooting is prohibited.
- All weapons must meet South Carolina firearms safety standards.
