# Molly's Rock Picnic Area

## Highlights

Molly's Rock Picnic Area is at the southern end of the Enoree Ranger District of Sumter National Forest. Built on the site of an old homestead, Molly's Rock Picnic Area offers a peaceful site to spend an afternoon. Large hardwood trees shade a picnic shelter built in the 1930s by the Civilian Conservation Corps. A fireplace and tables provide a cozy atmosphere even in inclement weather.

A small pond stocked with fish and a short interpretive trail are next to the picnic area. Kids can set up games or just run around in large open areas while the parents unwind.
