

National Recreation Reservation Service Summary of Changes from Contract Modification 4 and 5 to Contract Modification 6

1. SUMMARY OF CHANGES:

1.1. Purpose: The National Recreation Reservation Service™ (NRRS) contract specifications including Modification 5, were evaluated in terms of the current operational requirements. Contract Modification 6 is designed to integrate selected Department of Interior recreation sites into the NRRS contract.

1.2. Changed Sections and Attachments. The following contract sections contain significant changes to address this requirement. Significant changes are found in the following sections of the contract:

- Section C, “Scope of Work”.
- Attachment C-1, “Glossary and Definition of Terms”.

1.3. Other Changes. The following items were updated to document the changes in this contract modification.

- “Summary of Changes from Contract Modification 4 and 5 to Contract Modification 6”.
- Section A, “Solicitation, Offer and Award – Table of Contents”.

2. LIST OF CURRENT CONTRACT SECTIONS AND ATTACHMENTS.

2.1. Summary. This summary is designed to help the reader identify the most current version of the contract sections and to identify specific changes made. Table 1 shows the status of every section and attachment in the NRRS contract. “Original” indicates that a section or attachment has not been modified. “Contract Modification 4”, etc. indicates the number of the most current version for each of the sections of the contract.

2.2. Updating Contract Sections. For ease of replacement and to preserve consistent page numbering, contract Sections and Attachments, any change to a Section or Attachment, even if only a few words on a single page, are presented as amended in their entirety. The new contract modification number is indicated in the footer on every page of the Section or Attachment.

3. LIST OF SPECIFIC CHANGES FROM CONTRACT MODIFICATION 4 AND 5 TO CONTRACT MODIFICATION 6.

Section A – Solicitation, Offer, and Award – Table of Contents.

1. Pages 3-26 “Table of Contents”. Revised to add the new paragraph titles and corrected the page numbers for this modification.

Section C – Statement of Work

1. Page 1, Paragraph 2., “General Information”. Added comment that the abbreviation NRRS is used in the contract and represents NRRS™. This makes the contract easier to read and use over time.
2. Page 2, Paragraph 2.2., “Agencies Involved in This Contract”. Added text to indicate that two new agencies are now part of the NRRS.
3. Page 2, Inserted New Paragraph 2.2.2., “Bureau of Reclamation”. Added a new paragraph describing the existing camping facilities in that Agency will add to the NRRS.
4. Page 4, Inserted a New Paragraph 2.2.5., “National Park Service”. Added a new paragraph describing the existing camping facilities in that Agency will add to the NRRS.
5. Page 5, Table C-1, Revised the Title to read “Summary of Historical Reservation Data for 1995 – 1997 and 2003”.
6. Page 5, Table C-1. Added data on the Bureau of Reclamation and the National Park Service to the table.

Attachment C-1 – Glossary and Definition of Terms

1. Page 1, Definition of “Agencies”. Revised the text to add the additional Federal Agencies.
