

## Bibliografía

La siguiente bibliografía incluye las obras citadas en el texto, además de otras que se cree contienen informaciones útiles relacionadas al tema de este libro. El alcance y la composición de esta bibliografía reflejan tres características destacadas de la información disponible sobre los bosques tropicales:

1. Disponemos de muchos más resultados de investigaciones y experiencia de lo que generalmente se reconoce.
2. Los mayores avances se efectuaron no en la América tropical sino que en el hemisferio oriental y merecen la atención de los silvicultores de los neotrópicos.
3. Muchas investigaciones y experiencia prácticas en el campo de la silvicultura tropical se realizaron hace más de 20 años.

Aunque todas de las obras incluidas en esta bibliografía no se citan en el texto, las hemos revisado y juzgado como contribuciones positivas al tema de este libro. El hecho que se indica que el lugar de publicación y el nombre de la editorial de algunas obras son "desconocidos" no significa que no se evaluó. Refleja más bien requisitos impuestos después de haberse completado la compilación de gran parte de las referencias usadas en este libro. La anotación "desconocidos" significa que los datos completos sobre la publicación de la obra no están disponibles ni en los archivos del Instituto Internacional de Dasonomía Tropical ni en las principales fuentes bibliográficas tal como *Forestry Abstracts*.

Nos vemos obligados a pedir la paciencia y tolerancia del lector Latinoamericano ya que la bibliografía fue preparada inicialmente para la edición en inglés, y necesitaría un cambio muy a fondo para proporcionar una traducción completa de las fuentes en español. Sentimos esta falta, pero nuestra expectativa es que no ha de complicar la identificación u obtención de cualquiera de las publicaciones enumeradas.

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
